

AN ORDINANCE

ADDING: Chapter 6-12, Wastewater/ Sanitary Sewer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA, THAT:

Section 1: Chapter 6-12, Wastewater/ Sanitary Sewer System shall read as follows:

Section: 6-12-010 **Private Decentralized Wastewater Systems**

A private decentralized wastewater system is defined as any privately owned wastewater collection, treatment or disposal system that (1) serves more than one residential lot or business (2) has a daily flow in excess of 2,000 gallons per day or (3) which transfers flows between one parcel or tract of plan.

Private decentralized wastewater systems are prohibited in the Marietta Water service area. All residents and businesses shall be connected to and served by the public wastewater collection system or have an individual septic system which serves only their residential lot or business and shall meet all City of Marietta/ Board of Lights & Water and Cobb County Health Department requirements.

Section 2: It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.
