AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING

The City of Marietta and the Board of Lights and Water general fund position allocation chart, and compensation, position classification, and public safety and line worker career development plans for the 2021 fiscal year.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA HEREBY ORDAINS:

Section 1: The position allocation chart marked "Exhibit A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, is adopted for the City and the BLW effective for the pay period beginning at 12:01 a.m., December 27, 2020. This chart shall replace the general fund allocation chart previously adopted.

The compensation and position classification plans marked "Exhibit B," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are adopted as the compensation and position classification plans for the City and BLW effective for the pay period beginning at 12:01 a.m., December 27, 2020. These plans shall replace any compensation and position classification plans previously adopted.

The public safety and line worker career development plans marked "Exhibit C," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, are adopted as the public safety and line worker career development plans for the City and BLW effective for the pay period beginning at 12:01 a.m., December 27, 2020. These plans shall replace the public safety and line worker career development plans previously adopted.

The attached memorandum provides details regarding other changes and action items effective with the first payroll of 2021.

Section 2: It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, phrases and words are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase or word of this Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this Ordinance.

Section 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the Mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.
