

Ordinance No.: 8374**AN ORDINANCE**

**APPROVING:** an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024 Grant Fund budget to receive and appropriate Comprehensive Addiction Recovery Act of 2016 funding awarded in the form of a Subgrant of the Criminal Justice Coordinating Council to the Marietta Police Department to offset the costs of naloxone kits and law enforcement training in naloxone administration and establishing best practices for engaging with people suffering from opioid addiction.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA, THAT:**

The FY2024 budget is modified as follows:
