AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING the Order of Bond Schedule and Posting of Appearance Bonds

WHEREAS, the Order of Bond Schedule and Posting of Appearance Bonds having been amended to properly reflect the appropriate fines and mandatory add on fees as required by statute; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARIETTA, GEORGIA, THAT:

Section 1: The bonds that have been previously set by prior court order be amended according to the attached schedule.

Section 2: The clerk of the Municipal Court of Marietta shall continue to cause a driver's history to be obtained from the Department of Driver Services of the State of Georgia, or similar authority of the state of issuance of each defendant's driver's license, as to each traffic violation, and to have that driver's history attached to the citation.

Section 3: These shall be the bonds that shall be imposed, and any appropriate surcharge as required by State law, or otherwise, shall be added and calculated in addition thereto.

Section 4: The bond schedules that have been previously ordered, that are not specifically mentioned herein, shall remain the same.

Section 5: It is hereby declared to be the intention of this Ordinance that its sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases, are severable, and if any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of the Ordinance is declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, it shall not affect any of the remaining sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases of the Ordinance.

Section 6: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 7: This Ordinance shall become effective upon the signature or without the signature of the mayor, subject to Georgia laws 1983, page 4119.
